

## ACCOMMODATION FEES

The cost of accommodation, airport transfer, local travel, social and cultural programme and insurance etc differs according to the city in which your students will stay. The following prices are appropriate to PLYMOUTH only:

### Notes

1. Self Catering Accommodation does not include any food, bedding, towels or laundry.
2. These will need to be purchased separately.
3. Host Family Half Board accommodation includes breakfast and evening meals Monday to Friday and breakfast, lunch and evening meal on the weekends and bank holidays.
4. Host Family Full Board accommodation includes breakfast, lunch and evening meal 7 days per week
5. Bed and Breakfast accommodation provides only a room and breakfast. It does not include other meals or laundry which must be paid for separately.
6. Hotel accommodation only a room and breakfast. It does not include other meals or laundry which must be paid for separately.

### Notes

Events are timetabled throughout the year and occur on a Saturday. Examples include:

- Tintagel Castle – Mythical home of King Arthur
- Newquay – including Fistral Beach (home of surf championships)
- Polperro and Looe – Polperro is a protected traditional Cornish fishing village; Looe is a traditional fishing village but with contemporary attractions
- Torquay – Torquay proclaims itself as the English Riviera
- Exeter followed by Dartmoor – Exeter was originally founded by the Romans and has historical places of interest and a modern shopping centre; Dartmoor is a National Park (we drive through the park with two of three stops as places of interest including the Dartmoor Information centre and museum)
- National Marine Aquarium – not just a look at fish but an entertaining day out including a walk
